#### Activity 1: Hands-On Measuring and Estimating

Students need real-life opportunities to measure and estimate measures.

Look for opportunities when your child can:

- measure and build something
- look at distances a sports figure hit a ball, threw a ball
- estimate the distance you threw a ball and then confirm
- estimate the height of an object using a benchmark, the distance you ran, the distance you jumped
- track their height each month
- measure the length of a foot to buy new shoes
- measure a room for carpet or the yard for a new fence
- measure the distance to school
